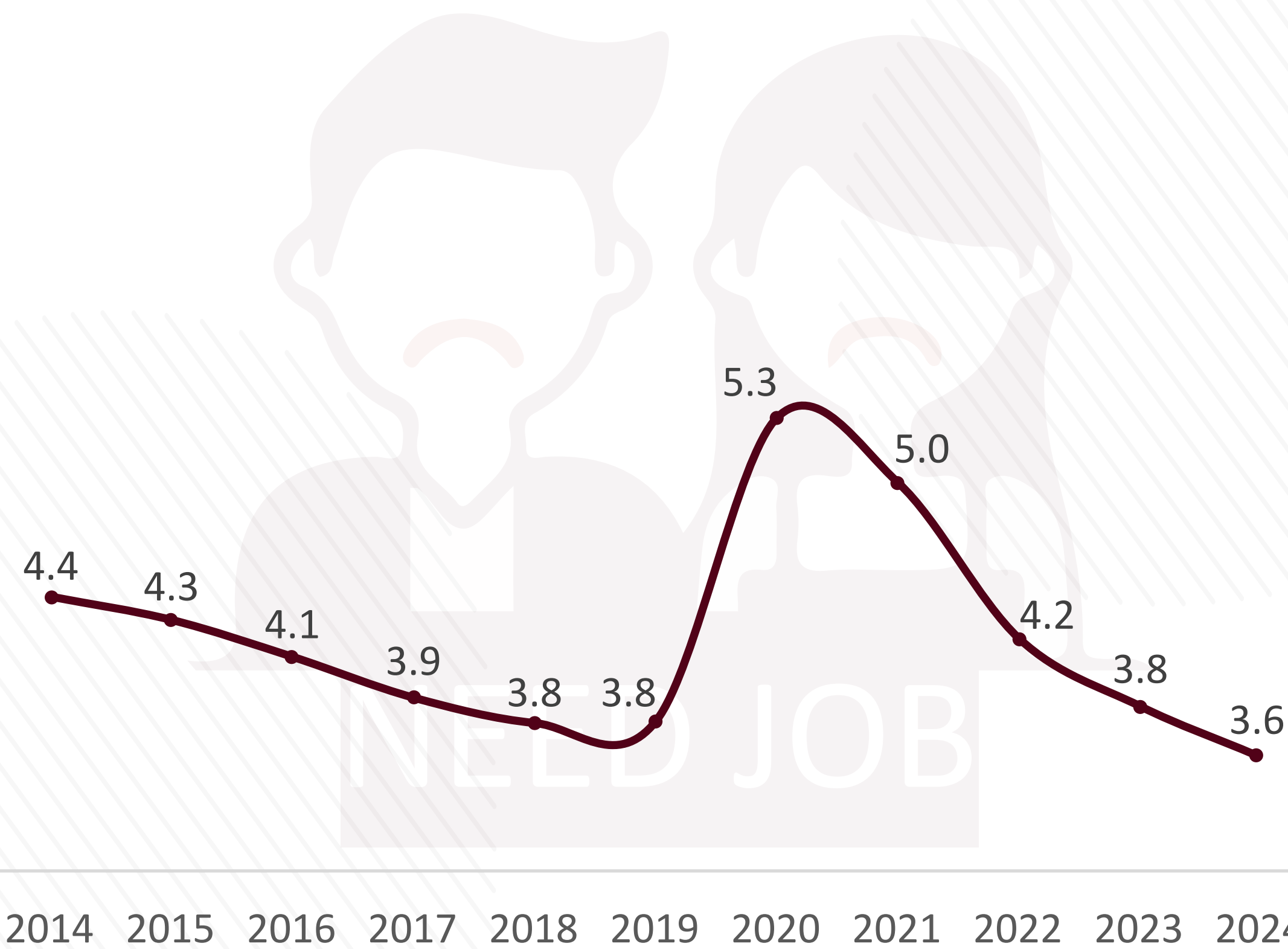

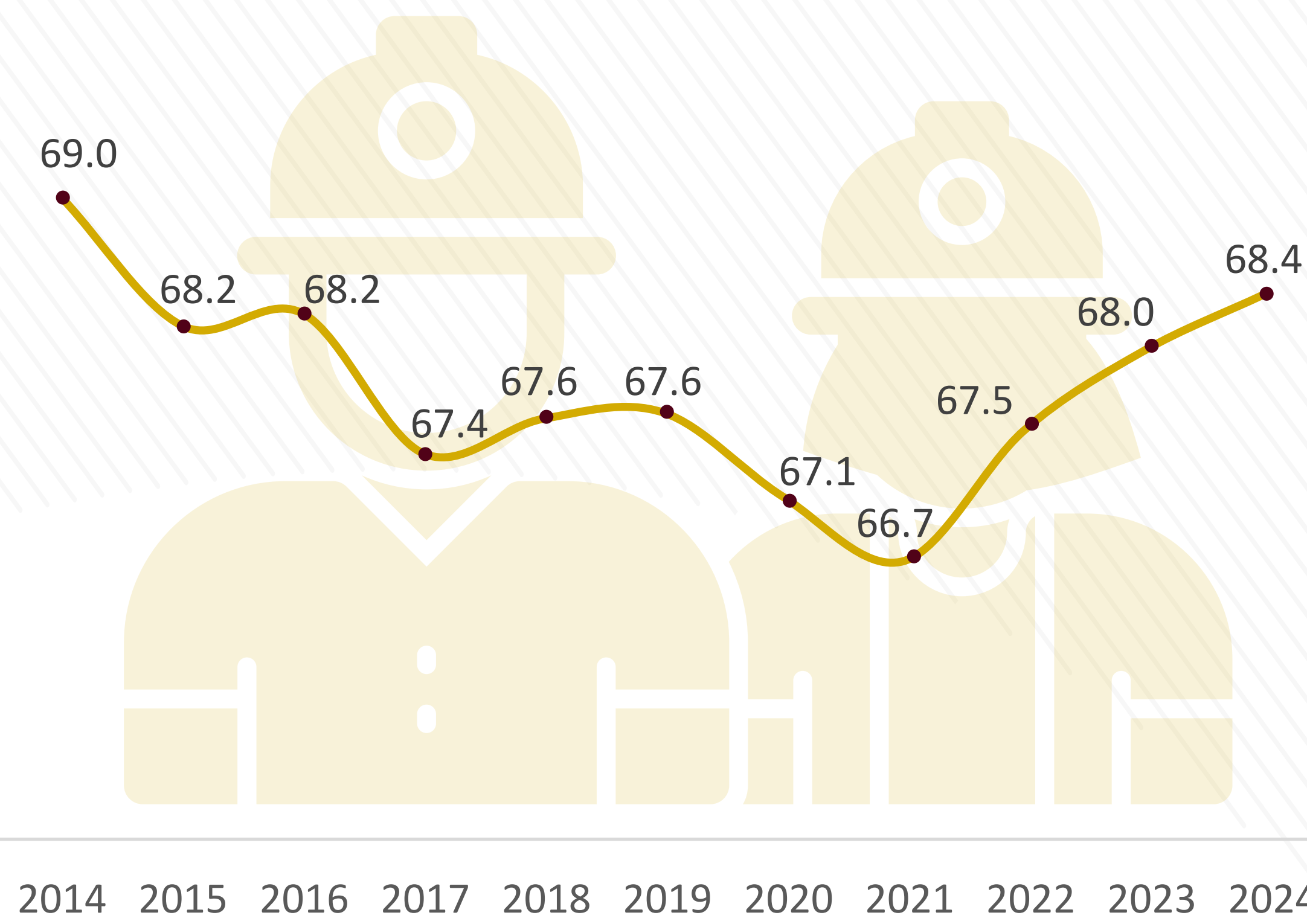

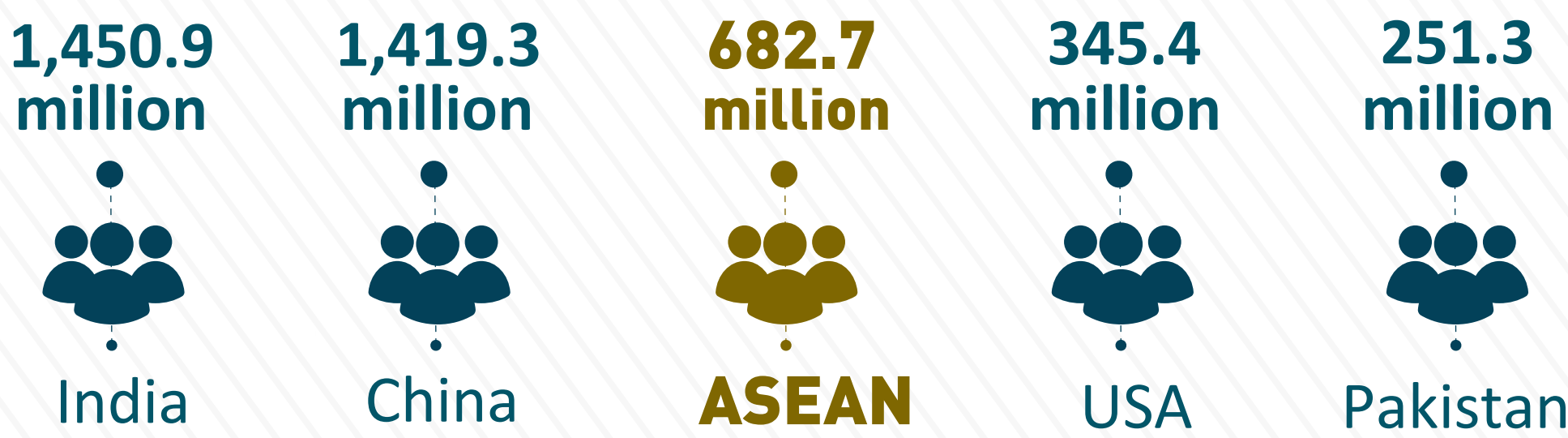


Labour force participation rate, both sexes (%)

ASEAN population ranked **3rd** globally, representing **8.4%** of the world's population in 2024.

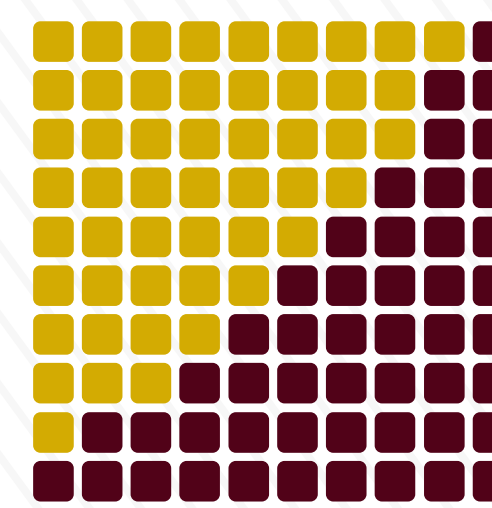


ASEAN's elderly population reached **8.2%** in 2024, nearly double the share recorded in 2000

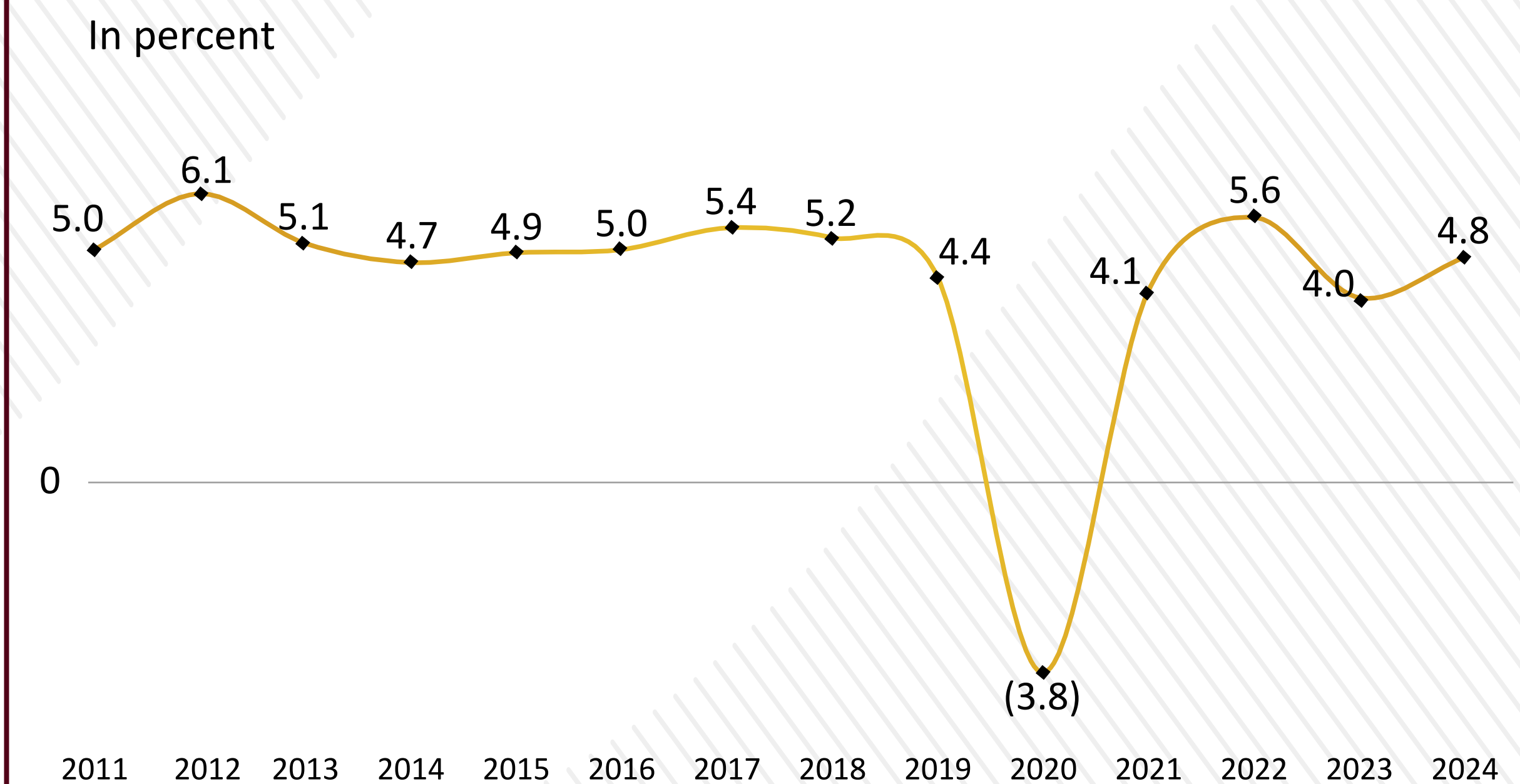

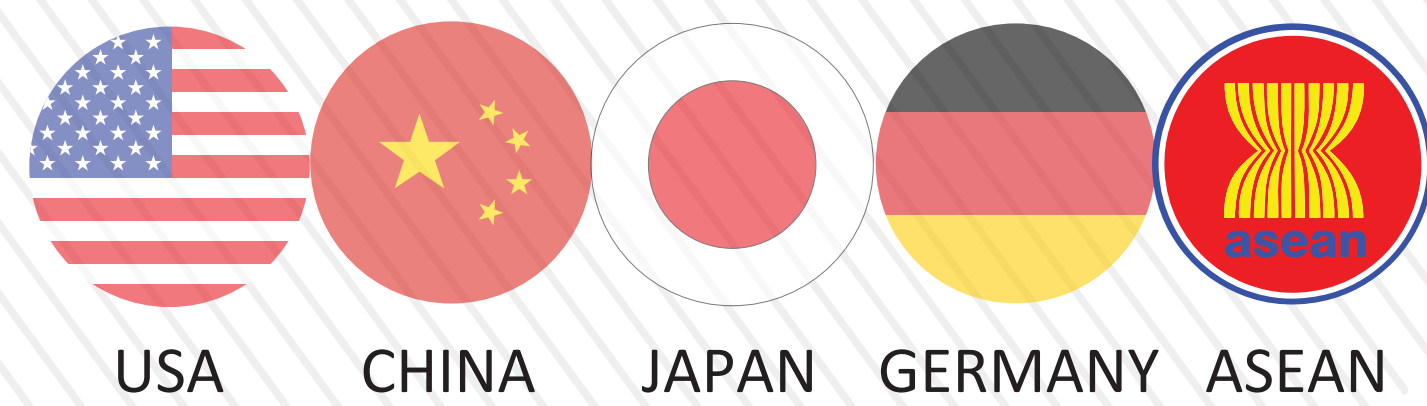

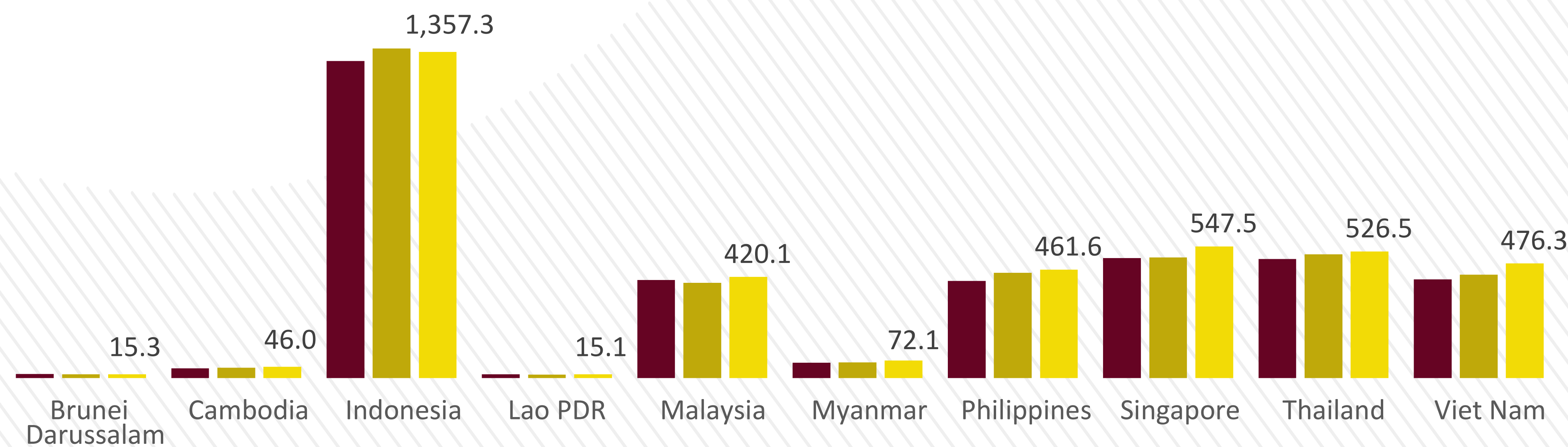


ASEAN economy grew by **4.8%** in 2024, maintaining a solid average annual growth rate of **4.3%** during 2011-2024.

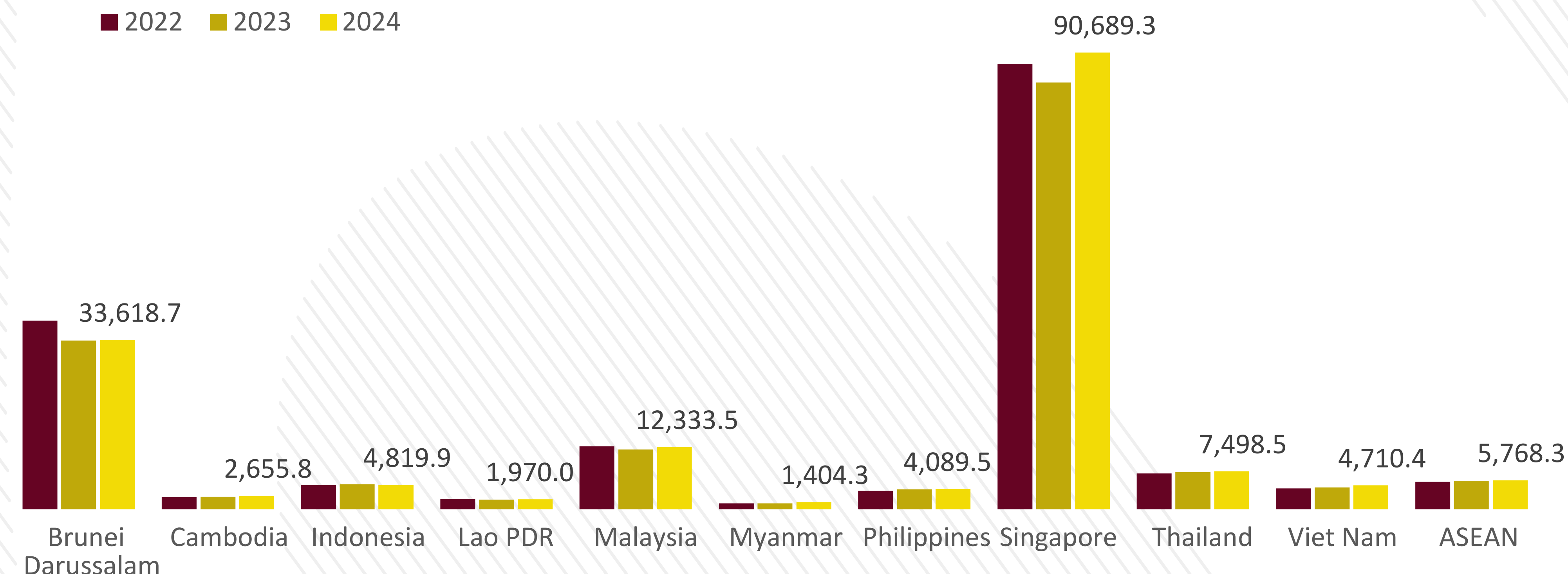

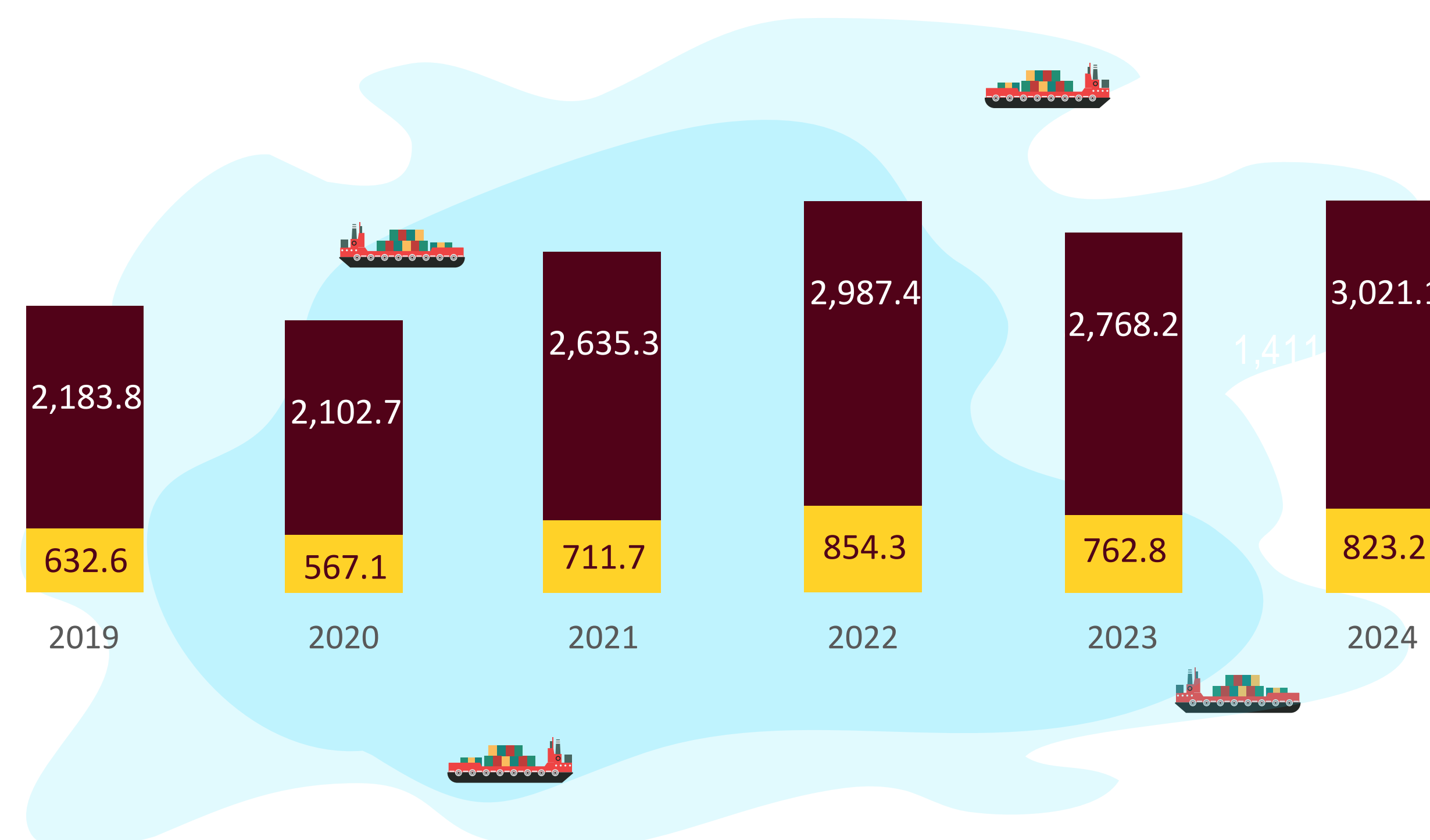

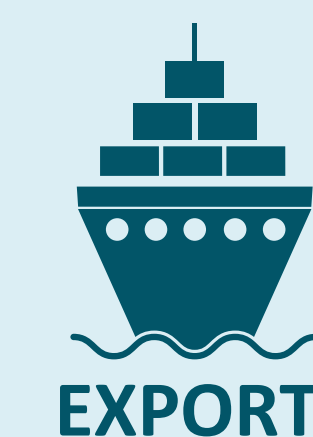
Total Trade in Goods (Intra-ASEAN and Extra-ASEAN), 2019-2024

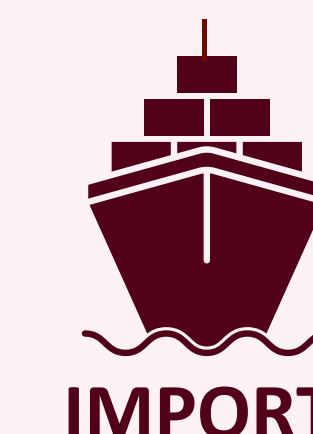

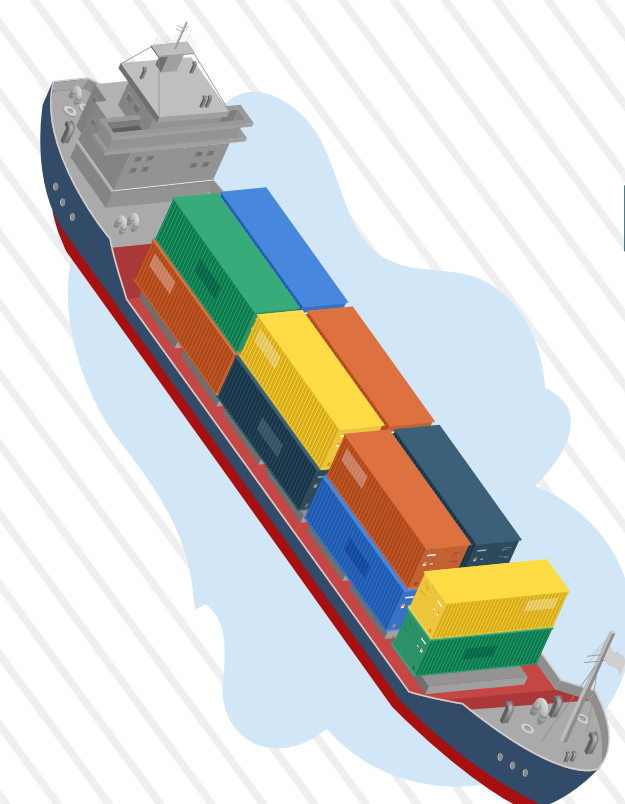
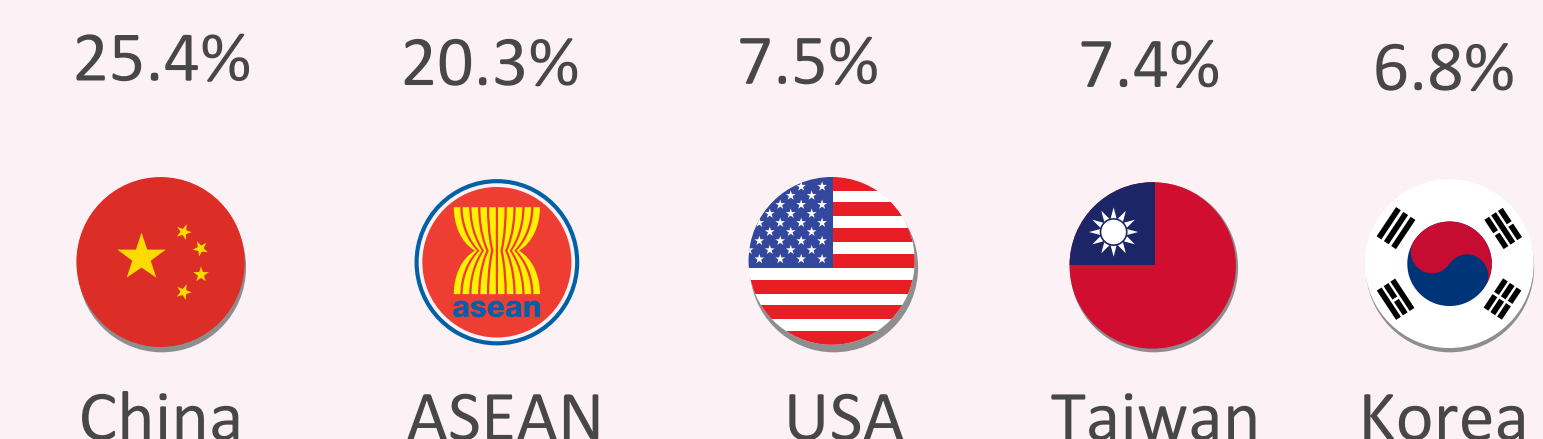
Exports-imports by partners, 2024

Balance of trade



ASEAN trade in goods recorded a trade surplus of **US\$ 61.5 billion** in 2024, a decline from **US\$ 101.1 billion** recorded in 2023.

Major trading partners



In 2024, **Intra-ASEAN** remained the top exports destination, accounting for **22.5%** of total exports, while **China emerged** as the largest source of ASEAN imports at **25.4%**.

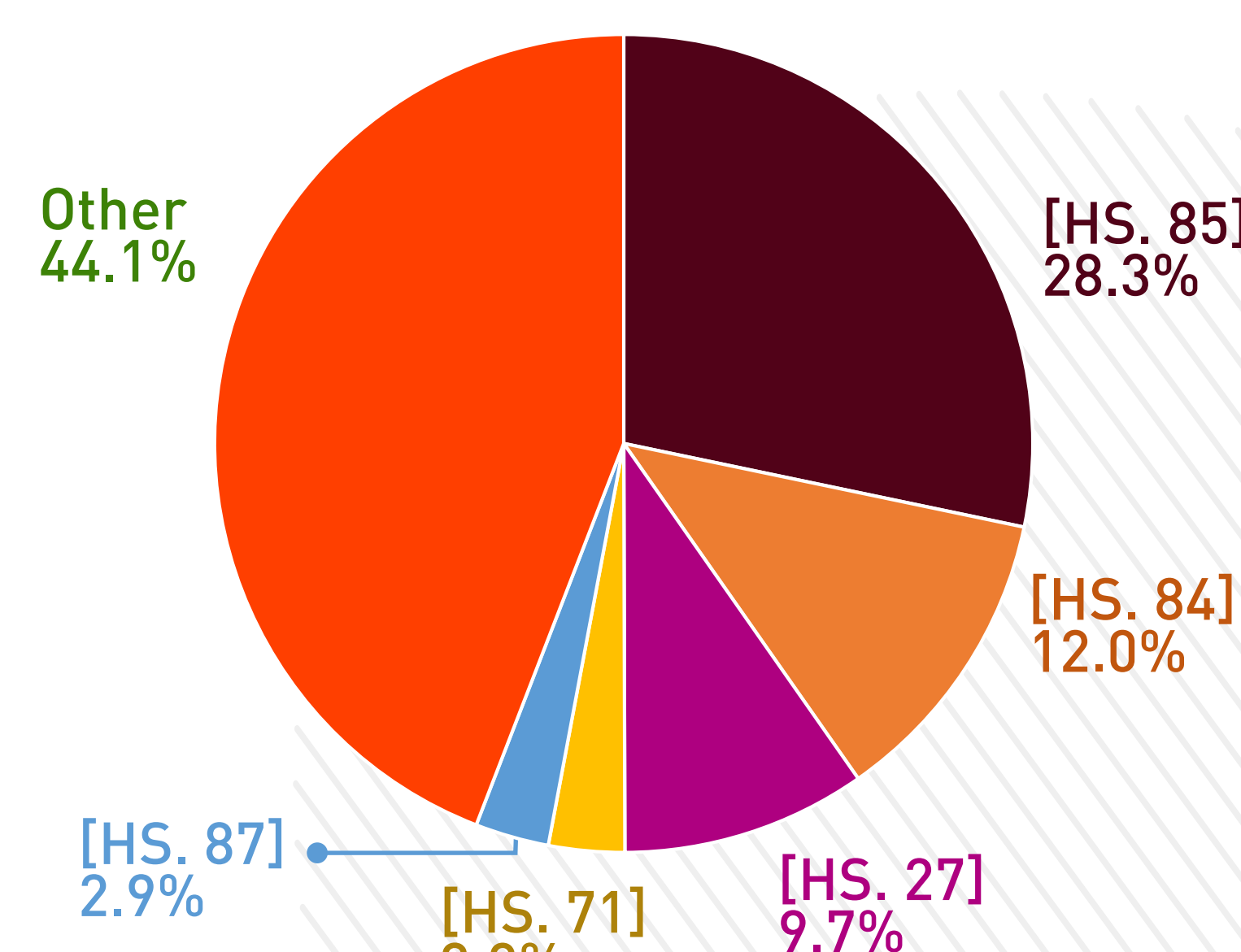

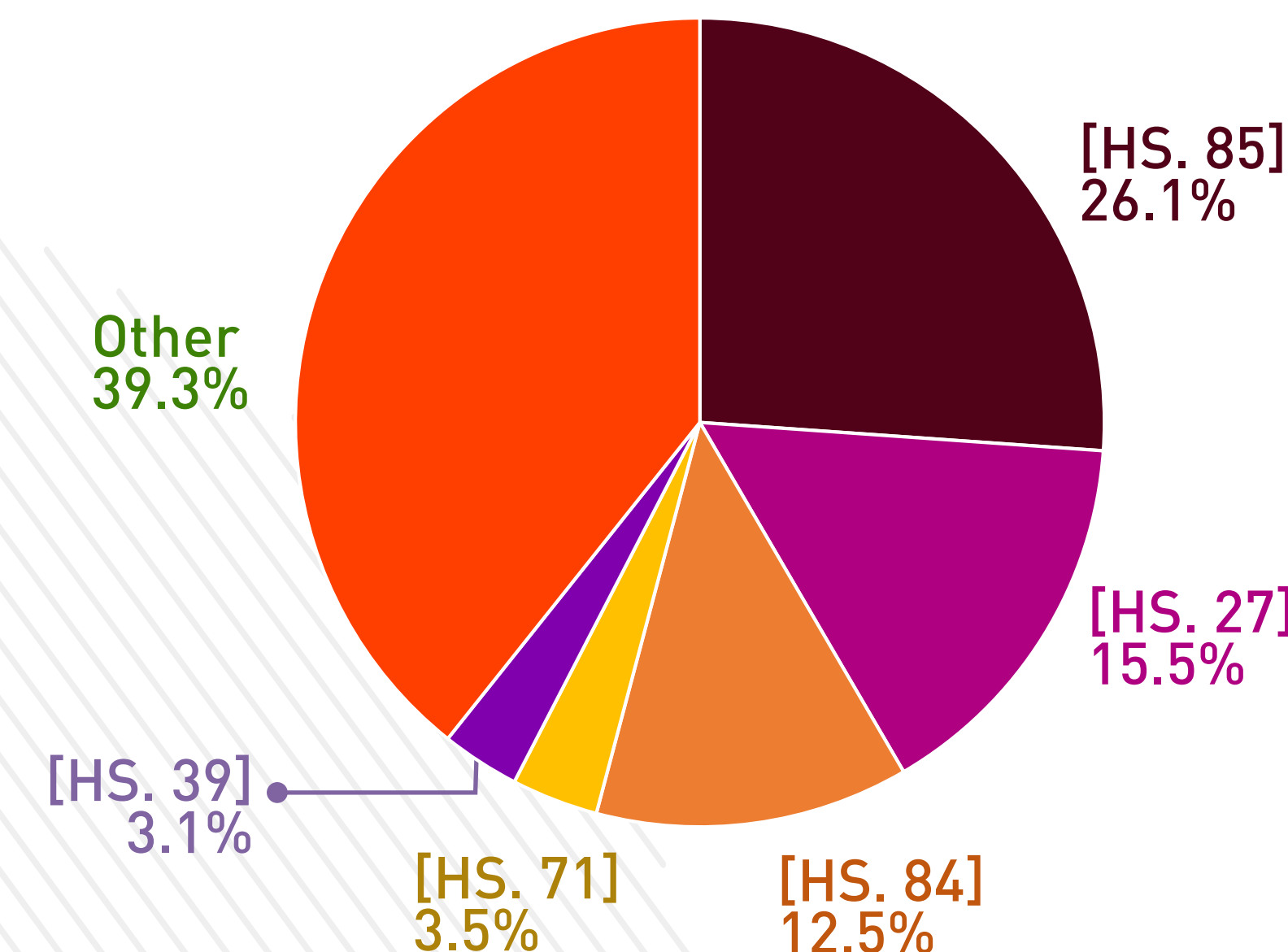

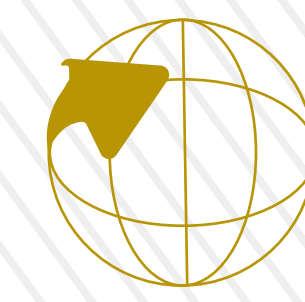

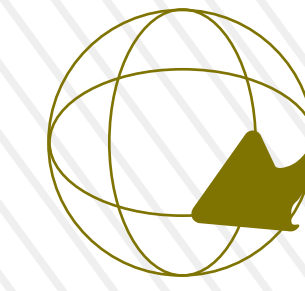
TRADE IN SERVICES

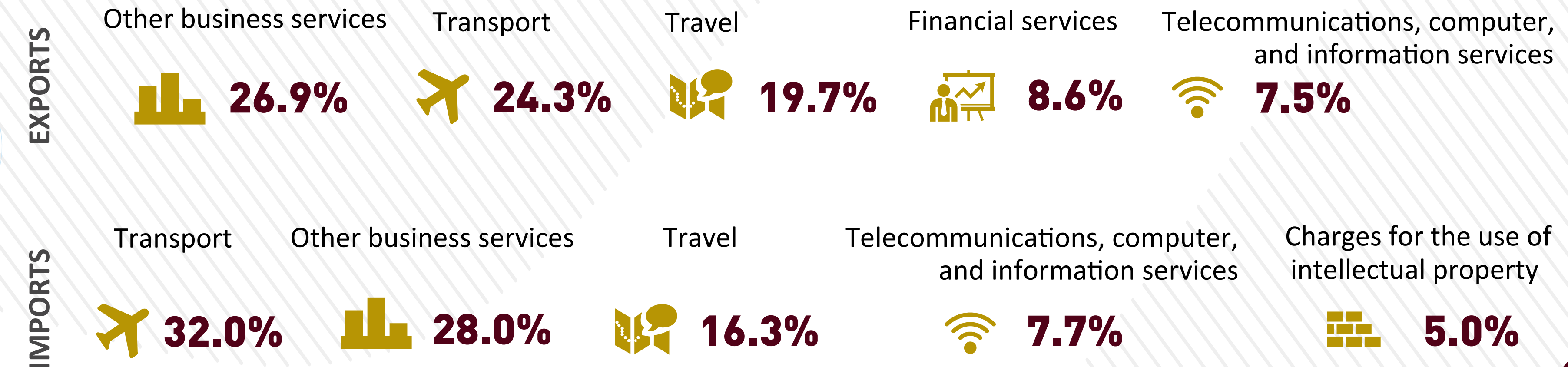

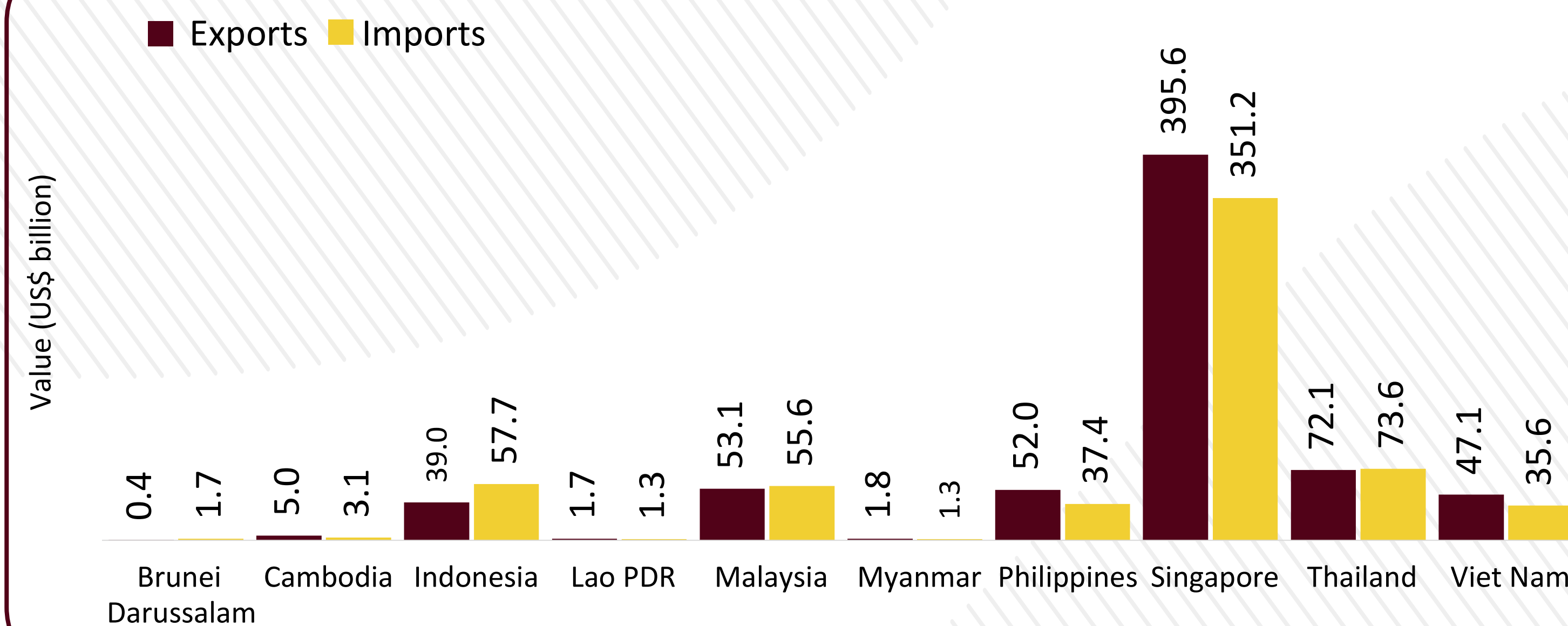

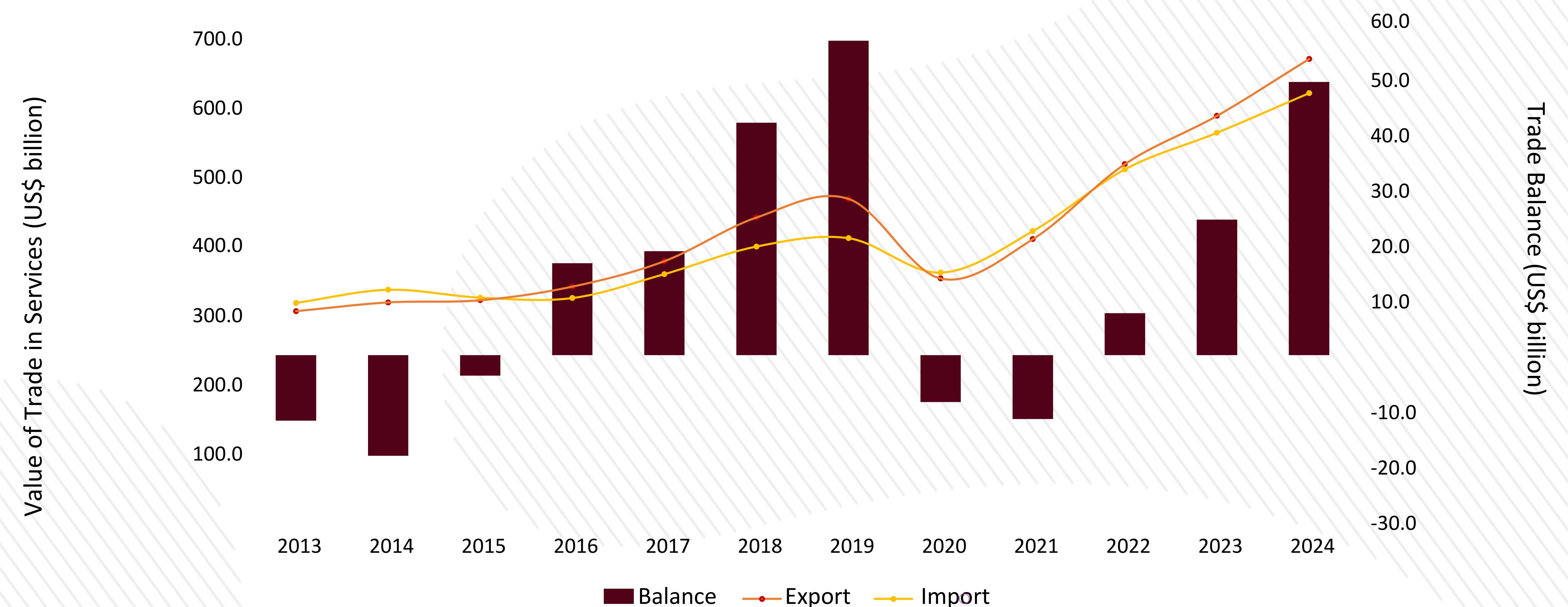

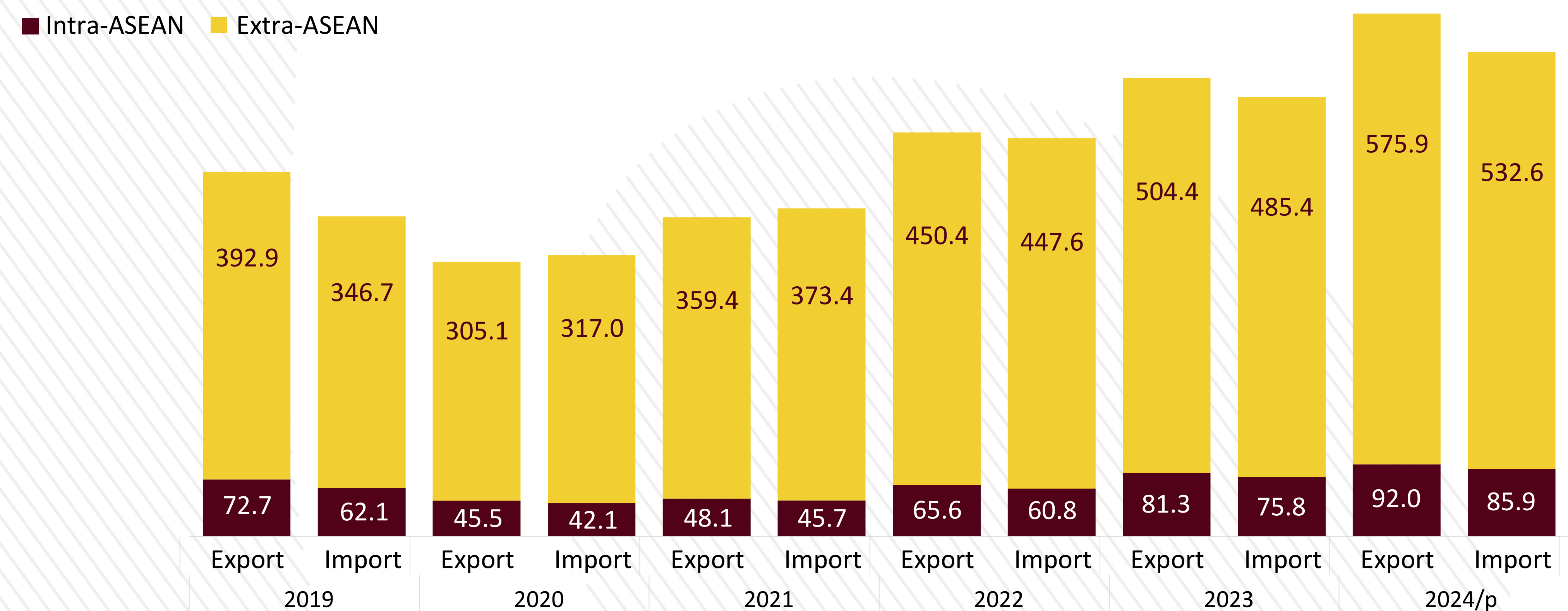

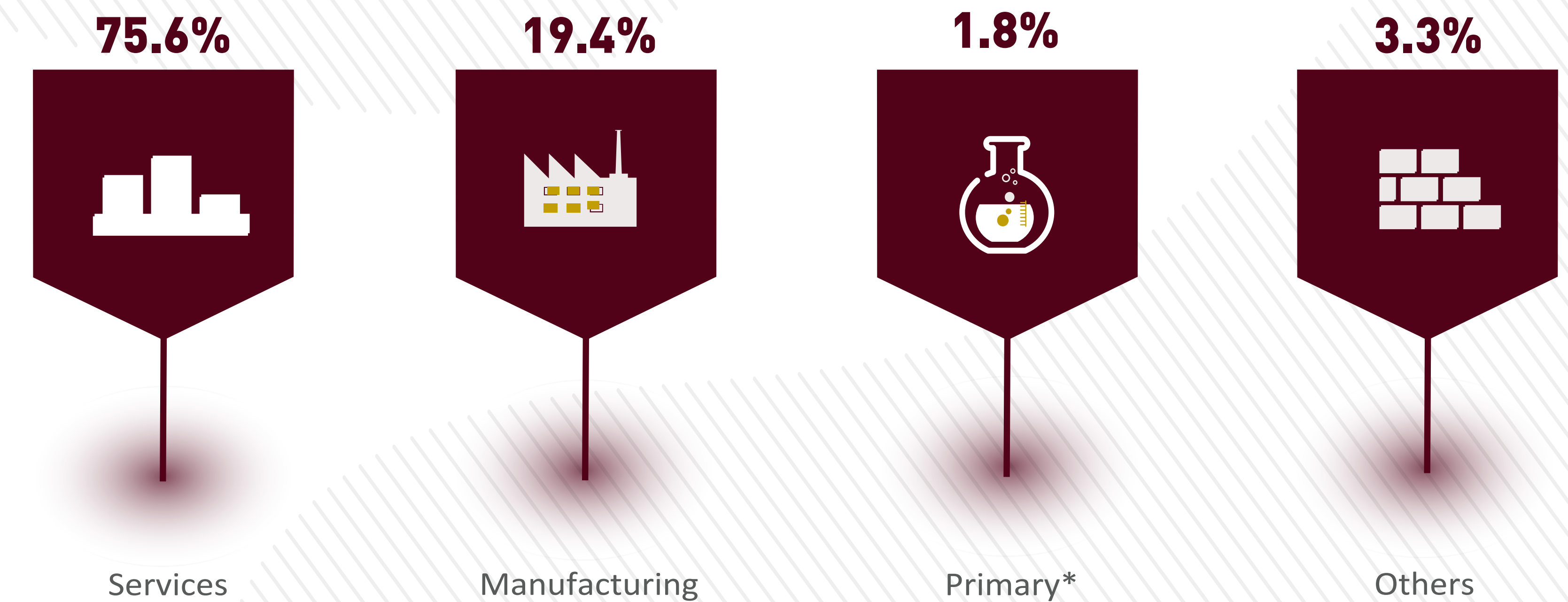

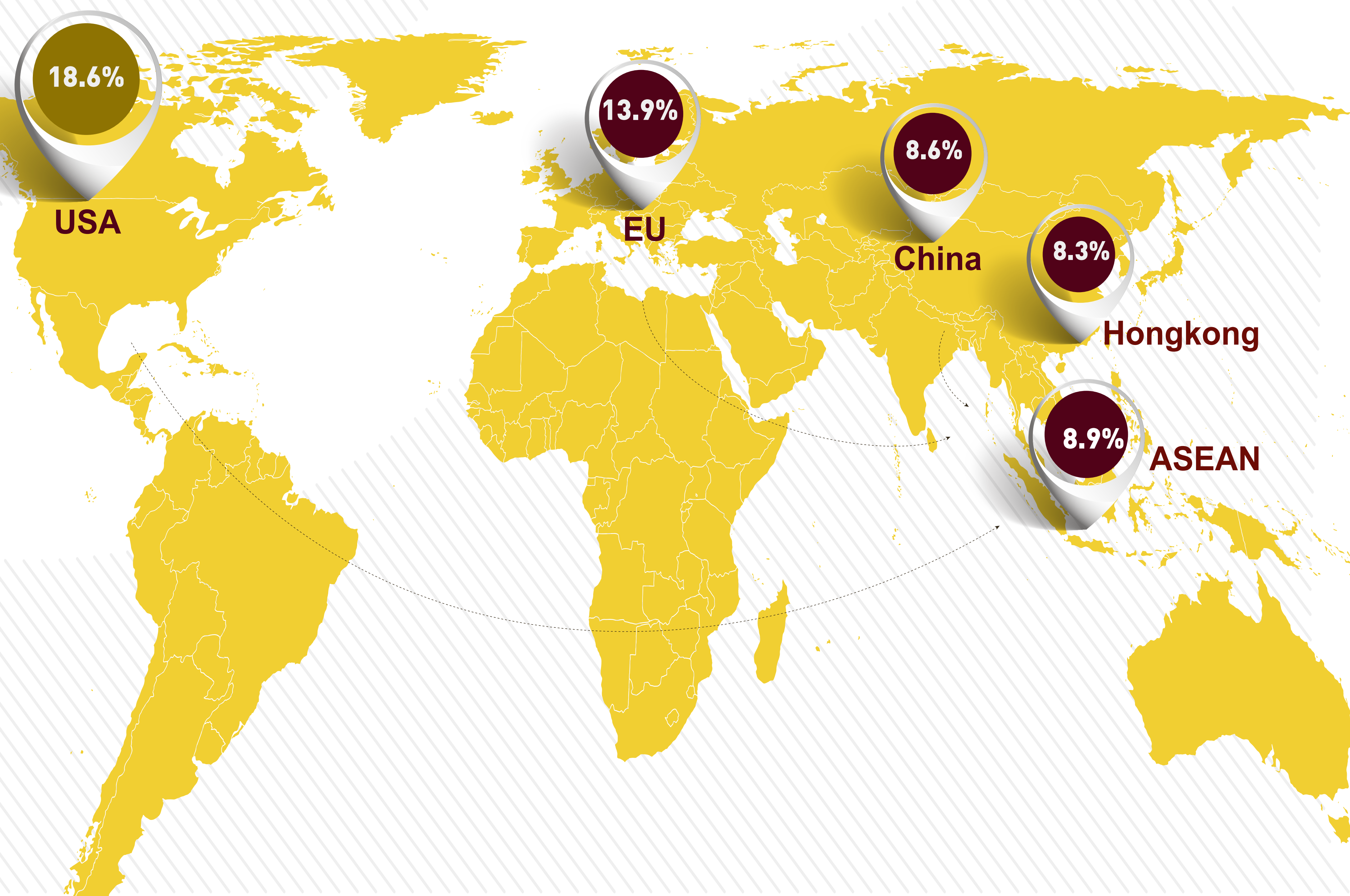

Flows of inward direct investment to ASEAN by economic activity, 2024

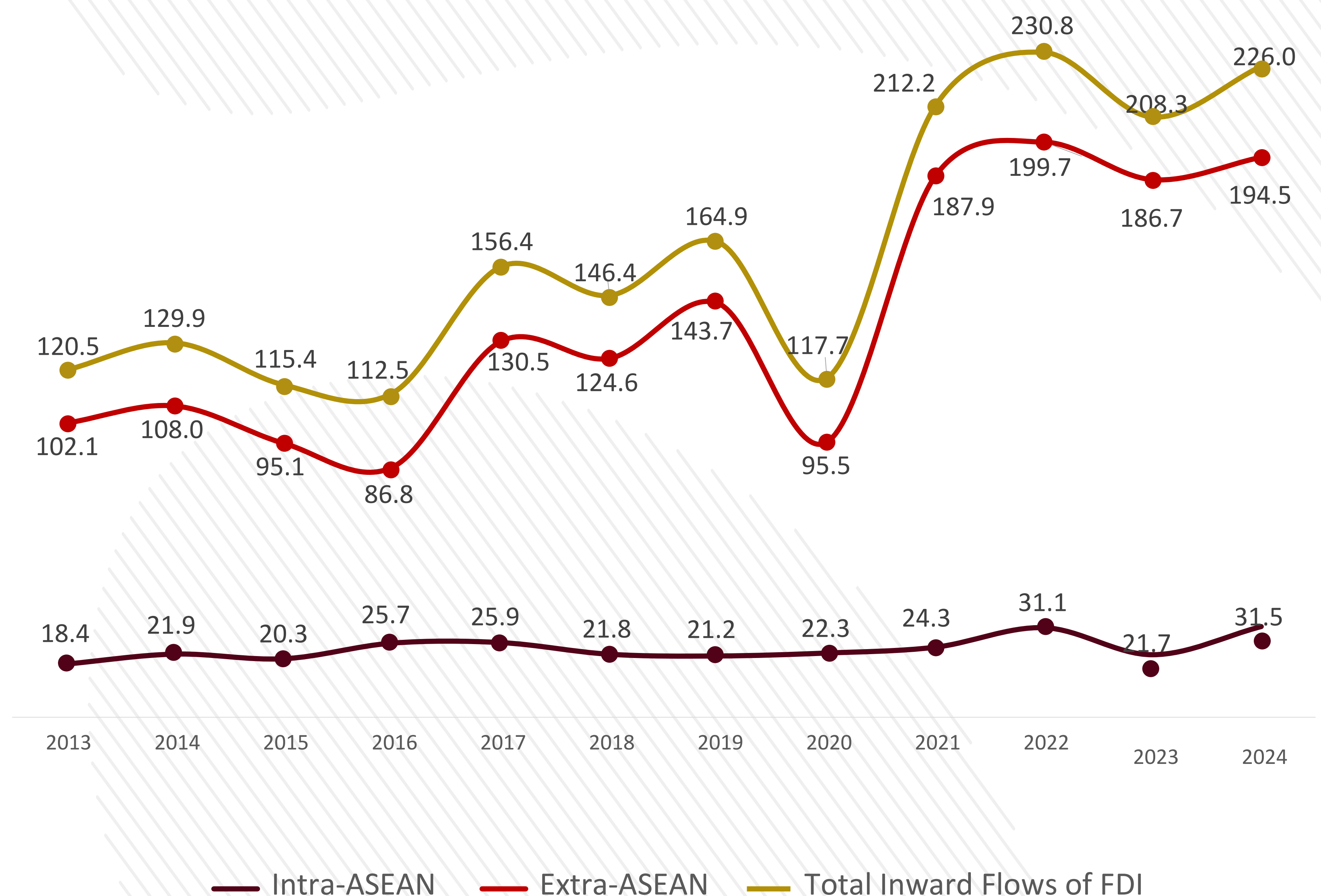

In 2024, internet users in ASEAN rose to **82.0** out of every 100 individuals.

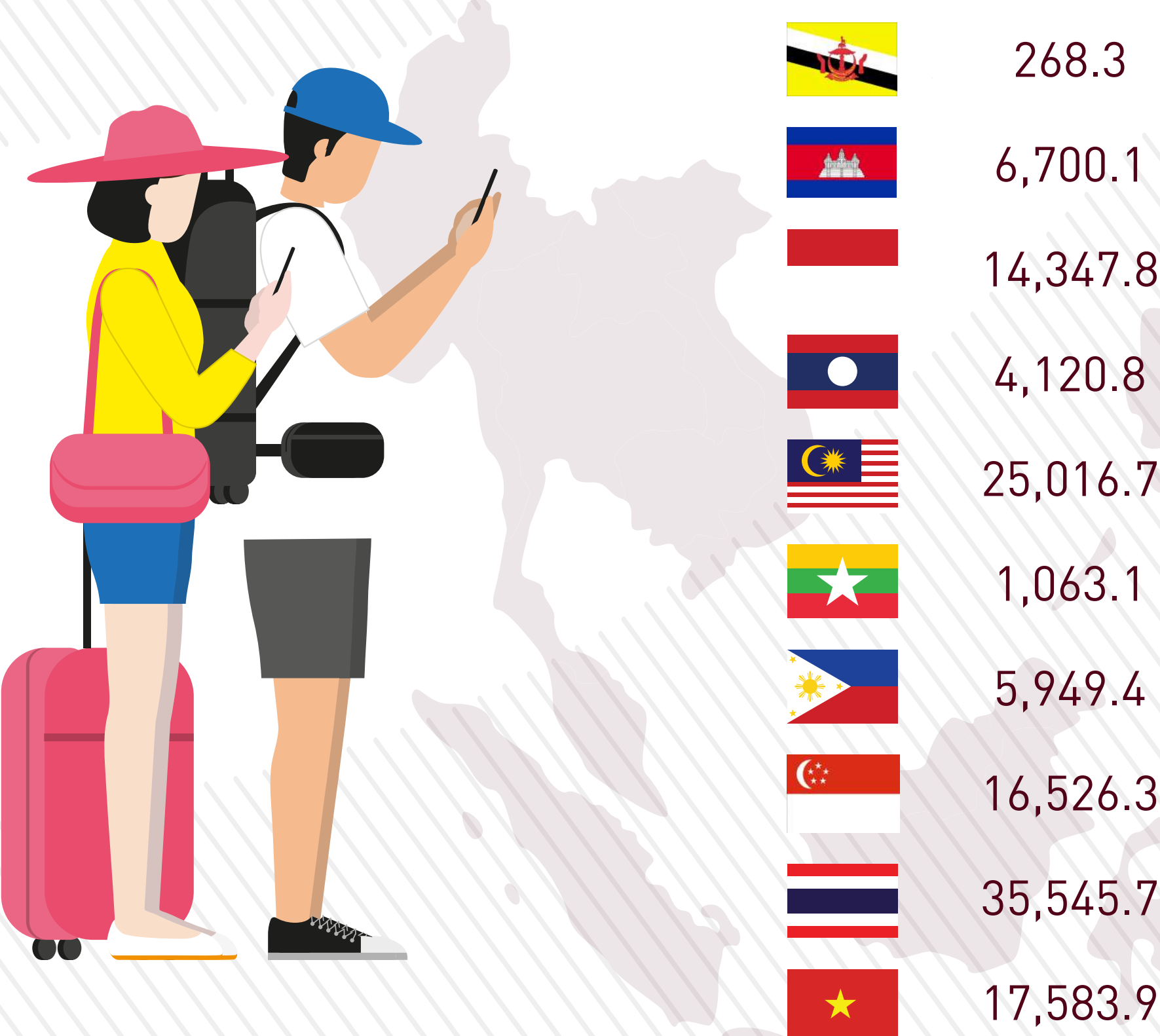

Visitor arrivals surged from **101.9** million in 2023, to **127.1** million in 2024.

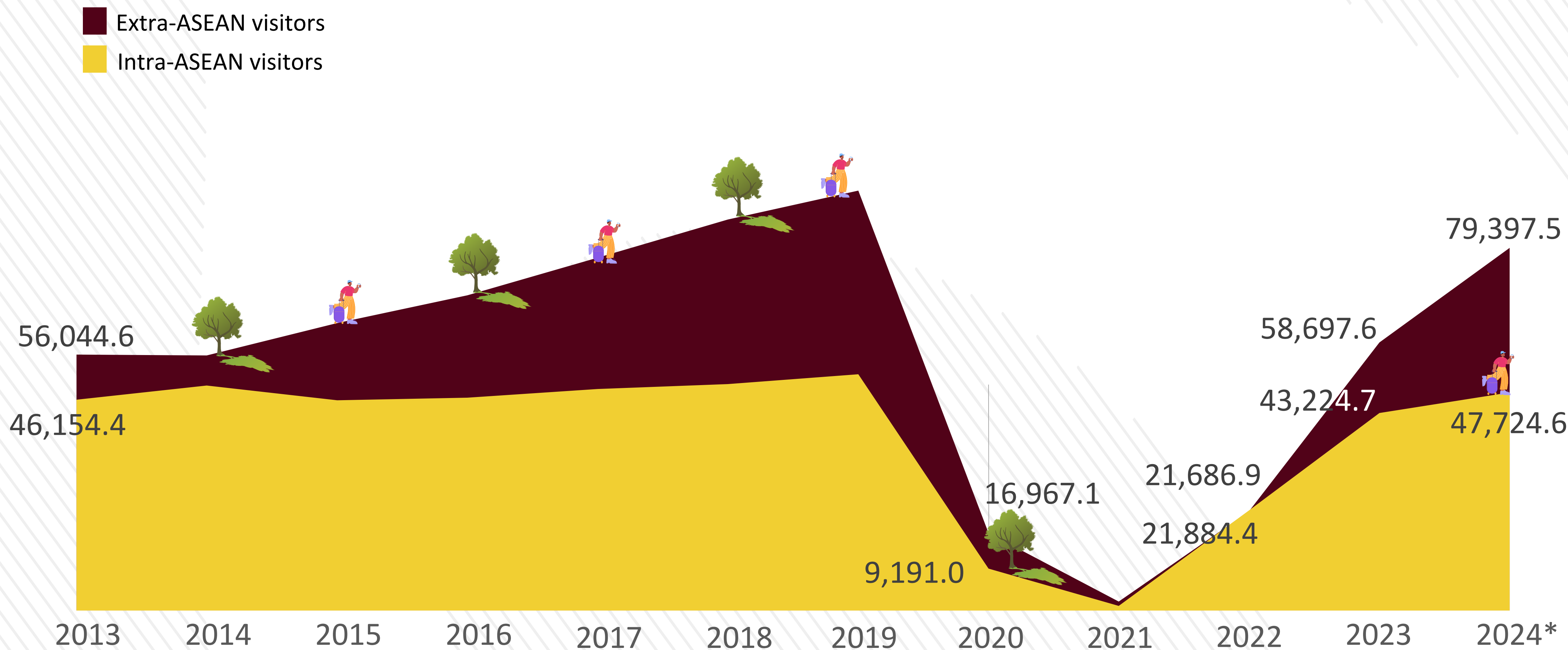
International air passenger, 2024
